Olivet offers an array of undergraduate and graduate degrees in more than 100 majors, minors and concentrated areas of study. Olivet has 116 full-time teaching faculty and 115 adjuncts in the undergraduate program. There are approximately 300 graduate faculty in the School of Graduate and Continuing Studies. There are over 30 additional personnel with faculty status.
